Combined Emergency Paediatric First Aid and Emergency First Aid at Work

LEVEL 3 : 7 HOURS TRAINING COURSE

This course is designed for those who are looking to undertake both the QNUK Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid (RQF) and the QNUK Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work (RQF).

RQF Level 3 Award

Qualification title: QNUK Level 3 Combined Emergency Paediatric First Aid and Emergency First Aid at Work (RQF)

This qualification will provide learners with the knowledge and skills required to act as an emergency paediatric and emergency adult first aider. This is ideal for first aiders who are likely to deal with adults, children and infants. This may include early years professionals or those working in leisure sectors.

Duration

Total qualification Time (TQT) is 7 hours, with at least 7 Guided Learning Hours (GLH) in the classroom over a minimum of 7 hours plus independent pre and post course study.

Course Content

- The learner will understand the role and responsibilities of a paediatric first aider
- The learner will be able to assess an emergency situation safely
- The learner will be able to provide first aid for an adult, infant and a child who are unresponsive
- The learner will be able to provide first aid to an adult, infant and a child who are choking
- The learner will be able to provide first aid to an adult, infant and a child with external bleeding
- The learner will know how to provide first aid to an adult, infant or a child who is suffering from shock
- The learner will know how to provide first aid to an adult, infant or a child with bites, stings and minor injuries

Numbers

A maximum of 12 students are allowed and must be a minimum of 16 years of age.

Assessment

The qualification assessment includes a written and practical assessment. You must successfully complete both assessments to achieve the qualification.

Certification

The qualification is valid for three years from the date of achievement. It is recommended that you attend annual refresher training. You will need to complete the full course again to re-qualify for a further three years.
