Emergency Paediatric First Aid

LEVEL 3 : 1-DAY TRAINING COURSE

This one-day Emergency Paediatric First Aid course has been designed for those who have an interest in child and infant Basic Life Support, including parents, carers or family members.

RQF Level 3 Award

Qualification title: Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid (RQF)

The qualification is for anyone with a responsibility for the care of children and babies and provides knowledge and skills to deal with a range of paediatric first aid conditions and incidents.

Duration

Total qualification Time (TQT) is 7 hours, with at least 6 Guided Learning Hours (GLH) in the classroom, plus some pre-course study.

Course Content

- Role of the Paediatric First Aider
- Primary survey
- Resuscitation (CPR including the safe use of an AED)
- Wounds, bleeding and shock
- Seizure
- Choking
- Minor injuries
- Recovery position

Numbers

A maximum of 12 students are allowed and must be a minimum of 16 years of age and a certificate can be offered to all, subject to assessment.

Assessment

The qualification assessment includes a practical demonstration and written assessment. You must successfully complete both the the written and practical assessments to achieve the qualification.

Certification

The qualification is valid for three years from the date of achievement. It is recommended that you attend annual refresher training. You will need to complete the full course again to requalify for a further three years.
